MAKE YOUR OWN

DURATION 40 MIN | 1 PERSON PER SESSION

In this 40-minute class, participants will experience a one-on-one workshop with a skilled glassblower who will guide them through the basics of working with hot glass using blowing techniques to make a small vessel.


KILN FORMING GLASS

GLASS & WOOD KILD FORMING

DURATION 6 HRS OVER 2 DAYS | CLASS MAX 6

Learn to carve wood and kiln form glass over the course of a weekend and take home a unique set of pieces. Using colour, shape, and design, participants will cut and arrange pieces of glass to form a beautiful glass platter whilst learning the fundamental concepts of creating glass objects in a kiln. After a night of firing in the kiln, participants will then work from a wood blank to carve an accompanying cheese knife.

GLASS BLOWING 1 BEGINNERS

DURATION 12 HRS OVER 2 DAYS | CLASS MAX 4

Spend two days with a professional glassblower on the Hotshop floor in this workshop in discovering the basics of glassblowing in a safe environment. In Glass Blowing 1, participants will learn to blow and shape molten glass to create simple objects such as baubles, paperweights, free-form sculptures, and vessels

SILVER & GLASS

DURATION 12 HRS OVER 2 DAYS | CLASS MAX 7

Enjoy a two-day jewellery making workshop consisting of one day of glass bead making and one day of jewellery design and assemblage. In this beginners beadmaking workshop, participants will learn to make a variety of beads and glass stringers over a flame torch. Once annealed and coldworked, the class will be taught the process of acid etching glass and the basics of jewellery design to forge and assemble glass and silver jewellery.

Neon beginners is a 2-day workshop where participants will learn how to stretch, heat, and shape glass tubes into basic curves and forms. NEON 2 CONTINUING

DURATION 12 HRS OVER 2 DAYS | CLASS MAX 6

Neon 2: Continuing will extend from the knowledge of basic bending, with a focus on lettering, how to sequence bends and splicing glass. The class builds on the skills of Neon 1 to break down the process of making a design into a workable neon layout, and will explore how to determine the appropriate materials, loading and accessories to complete the work in real time.

In this 8 week course participants will be guided through numerous glass making processes, including casting and coldworking, by highly skilled Teaching Artists. This course will demonstrate how to create 6 different wax moulds, cast them in crystal, and then fire and polish the resulting works to create a complete chess set.



DURATION 5 DAYS | CLASS MAX 8

REDUCE - REFINE - SIMPLIFY

WITH JESSICA LOUGHLIN

DURATION 6½ DAYS | CLASS MAX 8

The space we leave in our work can be more powerful than what we add. Students will use the theme of light and space as a starting point to complete projects that will concentrate on conceptual development and technical finesse.

With a focus on mastering simplicity, the first project will be structured on expanding kilnforming skills to create forms made from multiple layers of glass, fused in moulds and enhanced through using cold working processes. The second project will be more explorative. Time will be spent workshopping the transition from idea to object through discussion, model making and small individual explorations in glass before creating a finished piece.

CASTING POCKET FRIENDS

The Canberra Glassworks school group program connects to the design and technologies, visual art, history, and science components of the Australian Curriculum.

Participants in the Tour and Tile school program will attend a small group, hands on workshop to cut, design and arrange glass make their own tiles using the kiln forming method.

The tour component will explore questions such as:

- How does glass change from one material state to another?
- What is the chemistry of glass and how does that affect its colour?
- How important is teamwork in the Hotshop?
- · How many ways can we make glass?
- What makes glass a sustainable material?

Solid coloured crystal is inserted into the mould which is then placed into a kiln where the glass melts and takes the shape of each unique creation.
